SEMTRI breaks through the psychological 11,500-point level for the first time

The SEMTRI, the flagship total return index of the Stock Exchange of Mauritius, hit a new record high today and closed for the first time above the psychological level of 11,500 points, at 11,528.65 points.

Since inception in 1989, the SEMTRI has achieved an annualised total return of 14%, underpinned by the solid price and dividend performances of the bellwether stocks listed on the Official Market of the SEM.

Since the start of 2025, the SEMTRI has repeatedly surpassed its previous all-time highs, culminating in today's new record-high. Driving this strong performance are 13 companies that have each delivered double-digit total returns since the beginning of the year, ranging from 10.03% to 42.97%, showcasing their steady growth in earnings.
